Supervised Bail – This program is pretrial supervision. This would allow non-violent and non-sexual offenders the opportunity to remain un-incarcerated so they maintain employment, social security benefits, counseling appointments, family structure, and etc. Participants are supervised by a Day Reporting Center Officer. Supervision consists of office contact, electronic monitoring, drug testing, and alcohol monitoring. Some important factors this program allows for are mandated counseling, case management services, medication compliance and a pre-adjudication home plan.
