

Electronic Monitoring(EM)– The Probation Department utilizes EM primarily as a sentencing alternative for those offenders sentenced to Intermediate Punishment, but it is also used as a sanctioning tool for probation/parole violators. EM is a 24 hour monitoring system used to ensure that the individual remains confined to their residence with the exception of windows created for the purpose of going to work or attended approved counseling services and/or doctor’s appointments.

SCRAM (Secure, Continuous, Remote, and Alcohol Monitors) - Units are utilized for both electronic monitoring and alcohol detection. SCRAM units are designed to automatically test for alcohol twenty-four hours per day regardless of a person’s location.
