

Mifflin County CJAB Enhancement Program / Mental Health - All inmates assigned to the Mifflin County Correctional Facility (MCCF) are assessed for mental illness. Inmates who display signs of mental illness according to the initial mental health screening will be further evaluated by Probations Mental Health Officer. If the individual qualifies for possible diversion (based on criminal history, the nature of the current offense, and the individual's amenability to mental health treatment) a recommendation will be made to the court in regards to appropriate sanctions and treatment. When individuals with mental illness are released from the MCCF the Mental Health Officer will assure that individuals with mental illness leaving the MCCF are able to access appropriate treatment, housing, transportation, education, and employment opportunities.
