for the purpose of informing and taking public comment on an Ordinance amending the Mifflin
County Subdivision and Land Development Ordinance to set forth requirements for solar energy
systems. After the public hearing the Board of Commissioners will consider the enactment of the
Ordinance at their regularly scheduled meeting.
A summary of the Ordinance is as follows:
Article 1 of the Ordinance amends §2.200 of the Mifflin County Subdivision and Land
Development Ordinance (SALDO) by adding definitions applicable to solar energy systems.
Section 2, Article 4 (§4.215) of the Mifflin County SALDO is amended to delete solar
orientation and energy conservation and add a new section entitled Solar Energy Systems. This
section provides design criteria for accessory solar energy systems and solar energy facilities
(Principal).
The Ordinance provides the design requirements for solar energy facilities and also
includes decommissioning requirements for solar energy facilities.
