

**Mifflin County Juvenile Treatment Court** - The Mifflin County Juvenile Treatment Court will accept juveniles as a post adjudication program. The juvenile must be a resident of Mifflin County, be between the ages of 12-17, and the juvenile and their parent(s) must agree to placement in the specialty program. Eligible juveniles will include those whose probation supervision is revoked or those with a written allegation filed. Juvenile Treatment Court is utilized in cases where the juvenile is in need of intensive, community-based treatment and supervision. The program is also an alternative to residential treatment. A licensed drug and alcohol treatment provider must deem the juvenile as a substance abuser, and the juvenile must meet a level of care of intensive out-patient or greater. The program is extremely intense, consists of 4 phases, and is designed to be completed in 12 months.
