

County Intermediate Punishment- the County Intermediate Punishment Program is an alternative to county or state incarceration in accordance with PA Sentencing Guidelines. The program is monitored by the Day Reporting Center. The offenders will be under supervision provided by the Probation Department after being ordered by the sentencing Judge. The Program normally starts with a short period of incarceration followed by a period of electronic monitoring. Other requirements consist of reporting to the center on pre-determined days, obtaining and maintaining employment, attendance at recommended counseling sessions, remaining drug and alcohol free and any other requirements that the probation staff feel are necessary to assist the offender.
