Alcohol Highway Safety School-The Mifflin County Probation Office has been designated by the court as the county's single DUI program coordinator. As the programs designee, it is Probation's responsibility to establish and maintain a course of instruction regarding the problem associated with alcohol or controlled substance use and driving. To that end, this office is responsible for conducting the Court Reporting Network (CRN) for all DUI offenders along with instructing the court ordered Alcohol Highway Safety School. Classes which consist of a minimum of 12 1/2 hours of classroom instruction are led by staff who have been trained and certified by the PA DUI Association. The object of the school is to encourage a positive change in the students' attitude concerning driving under the influence of alcohol or a controlled substance through education.
